- Controlling invasive weeds like blackberry, ivy, pittosporum, etc
- Removing pests like rabbits, foxes and Indian mynas
- Protecting native flora and fauna
- Planting indigenous flora – Yarra Ranges Council’s Ribbons of Green Program and Melbourne Water’s Healthy Waterways Program
- Improving soil health and land management
- Maintaining and improving the health of Chum Creek and its tributaries
